RULE 4 PARAGRAPH 3

3. Qualified Professional teachers, who are fully paid up members of a recognised Association, may make application to become members of the B.A.T.D. at the discretion of the Executive Council. Existing qualifications will be taken into consideration when applying and if found acceptable will allow the applicant to be enrolled as a member. Associate or Membership qualifications will be considered in the application for a level transfer. Fellows will only be admitted at Membership level. Applicants who wish to become a Fellow of the B.A.T.D. in any branch, must adhere to existing Rules of the Association. The applicant must enclose with the application form the appropriate fees and documentation as required by the Executive Council. He/she may not stand for or be appointed to any office until he/she has taken the relevant B.A.T.D. examinations.

Effective 1st January 2017, members wishing to enter students for B.A.T.D. Majorette examinations must hold a qualification in the B.A.T.D. Majorette branch.

Effective 1st January 2017, non-members who hold a qualification with another recognised association can only enter students for B.A.T.D. examinations in branches in which they hold a qualification with their own Association.

GENERAL

The Application Form shall in each case be fully completed and forwarded to the General Secretary, along with Application fee (which includes current year's subscription). All application forms for membership, ASSOCIATE OR MEMBER, must include a declaration of the applicant's date of birth. Completed application forms will be submitted to the Executive Council by the General Secretary at the following meetings - January, March, June, September and November. Applications accepted by the Executive Council for membership of the B.A.T.D. will be notified following that meeting.

Only one branch of dance to be transferred from current Association to the B.A.T.D. per application.

A copy of the Examination Report form in relation to this application, plus a copy of the current year's membership card from current Association to be enclosed with application form and fees.

The annual subscription for all branches becomes due on the 1st January of subsequent years irrespective of joining date.
